

In General, an amateur driver is a driver who has not received valuable compensation for his or her services as a driver in the past 5 years. To participate in all club events, a person must hold a P category or higher driver's license (fair license for the fairs), is a current member of the MADC, and is in good standing at the locally affiliated racetrack. The MADC will decide all questions regarding a person's status as a club driver. In addition, each applicant must comply with all rules of The Maine Harness Racing Commission. Your membership must be paid and your name with the judges before you can enter a horse.
